

MISSION COMMITTEE – 2009

No mission committee was formed this year.

The treasurer reported that we have completed our pledges for 2009 as follow:

\$2500 to Presbytery for General Mission

\$1000 to Urban Mission

\$ 100 to Salary Partnership

We also supported the following mission projects:

Our congregation supported both the local food bank at St. Andrew and the Watertown Urban mission with our contributions of food and toiletries.

The Fellowship Circle set up its mitten tree during Advent to collect mittens, hats and gloves which were distributed to the Urban Mission, Jubilee Shop, and Sackets Harbor School.

The Deacons always coordinate the Jubilee Shop. This Christmas the Shop provided gifts for 54 local children in 18 families. A new mission for the Deacons this year was participation in the Sackets Harbor School backpack program. The Deacons donated 20 backpacks and \$200 for food to help launch the program.
